Dear Parent/Carer

I am just writing to you remind you of the arrangements for our Year 11 Prom.

Our Year 11 Prom will be held on Tuesday 4 July 2017 from 7.30-11.00pm at The Spa, Scarborough.

Tickets will be priced at £30.00. The ticket price includes a fruit cocktail on arrival, sit down meal (Roast chicken, mixed vegetables and potatoes, followed by Profiteroles, ice cream and chocolate sauce), disco and one Prom photograph. Additional photographs can be purchased on the night and details will be provided with the Prom Ticket. There will also be a non-alcoholic bar available. If your child has any special dietary requirements please could you inform Mrs Simpson at the school.

Students are expected to behave in an exemplary fashion at the Prom – staff are on hand to supervise and any student behaving unacceptably or inappropriately will be sent home.

Any student who arrives under the influence of drink/drugs or who has been obviously drinking alcohol will not be allowed entry and parents will be contacted to take them home. If parents are not available then we will contact the Police as we cannot take responsibility for students who cannot be responsible for themselves.

Please note, parents/carers will not be allowed inside the venue to take photographs.

The Spa is a non-smoking/vaping venue and we do not expect any student to be smoking within the venue itself or in the vicinity. Any student who leaves the venue to smoke will not be allowed back inside.

We would be grateful if you could ensure your child makes specific arrangements for the end of the night. Staff will remain at The Spa until the last student has safely departed.

We are looking forward to the usual good natured final event for our Year 11 students. There have been no problems in the past and providing everyone abides by the guidelines above I do not expect any this year. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the ongoing support you give to your child and the School.
