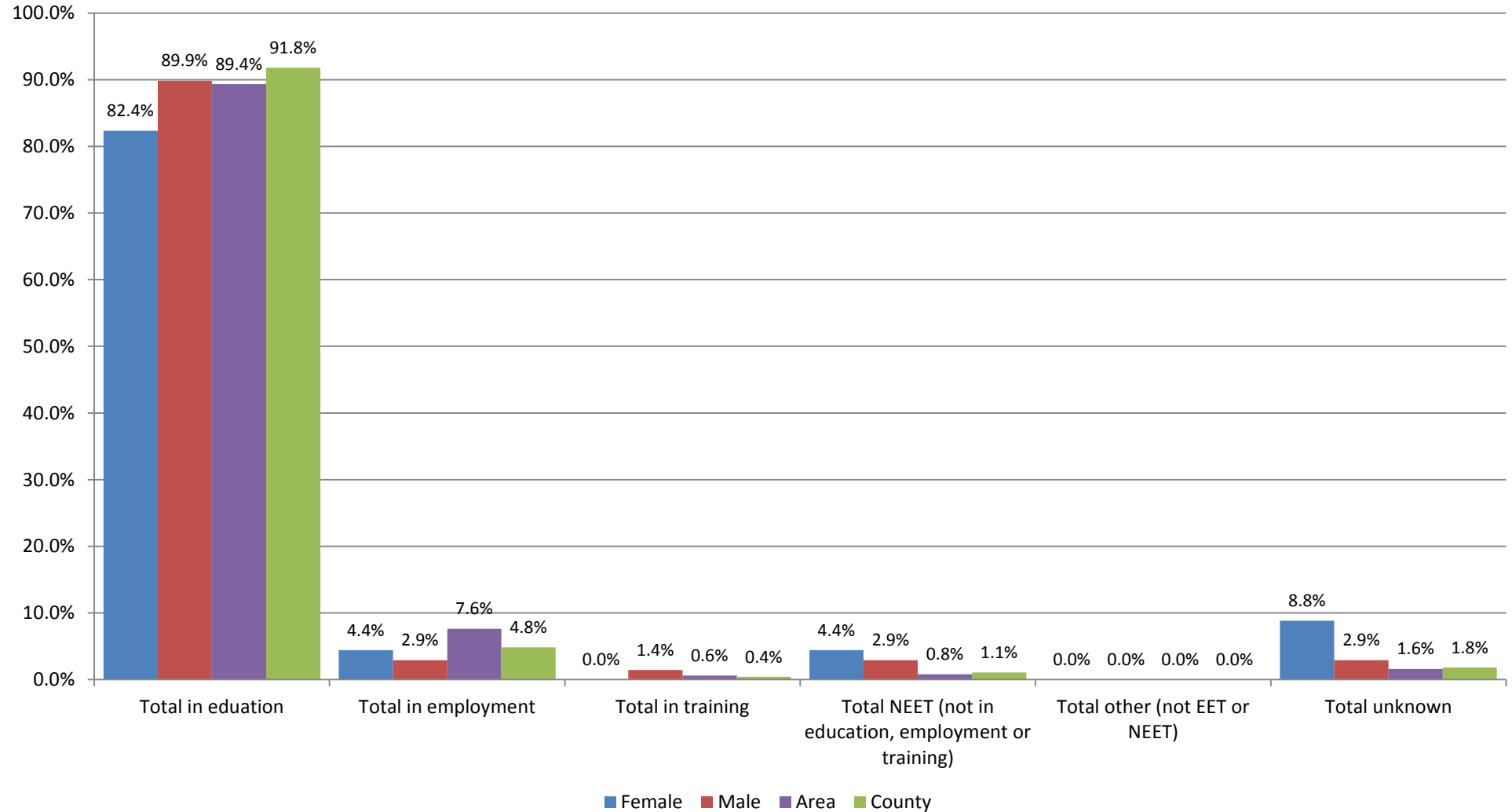

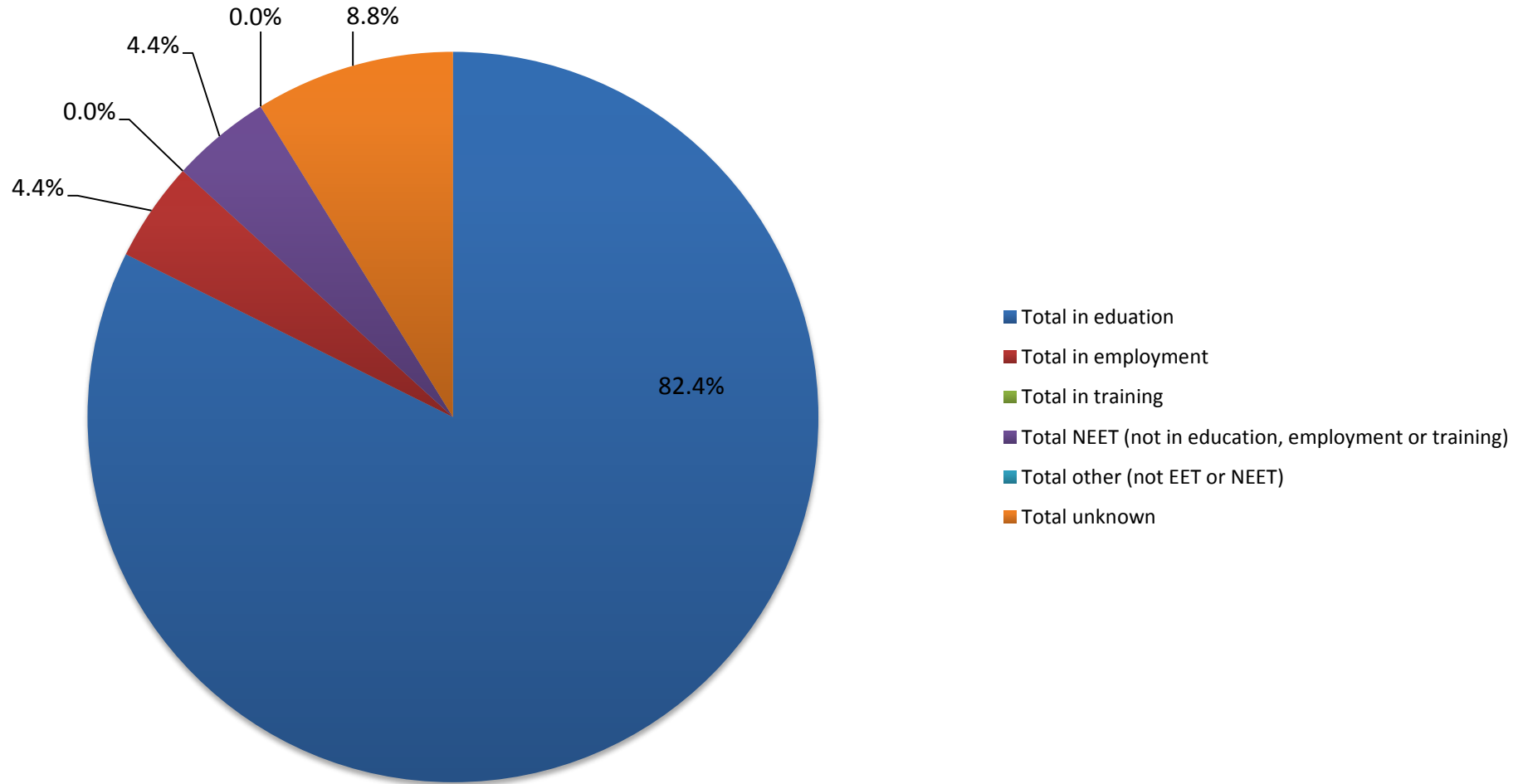


### Leavers breakdown by gender compared to area and North Yorkshire



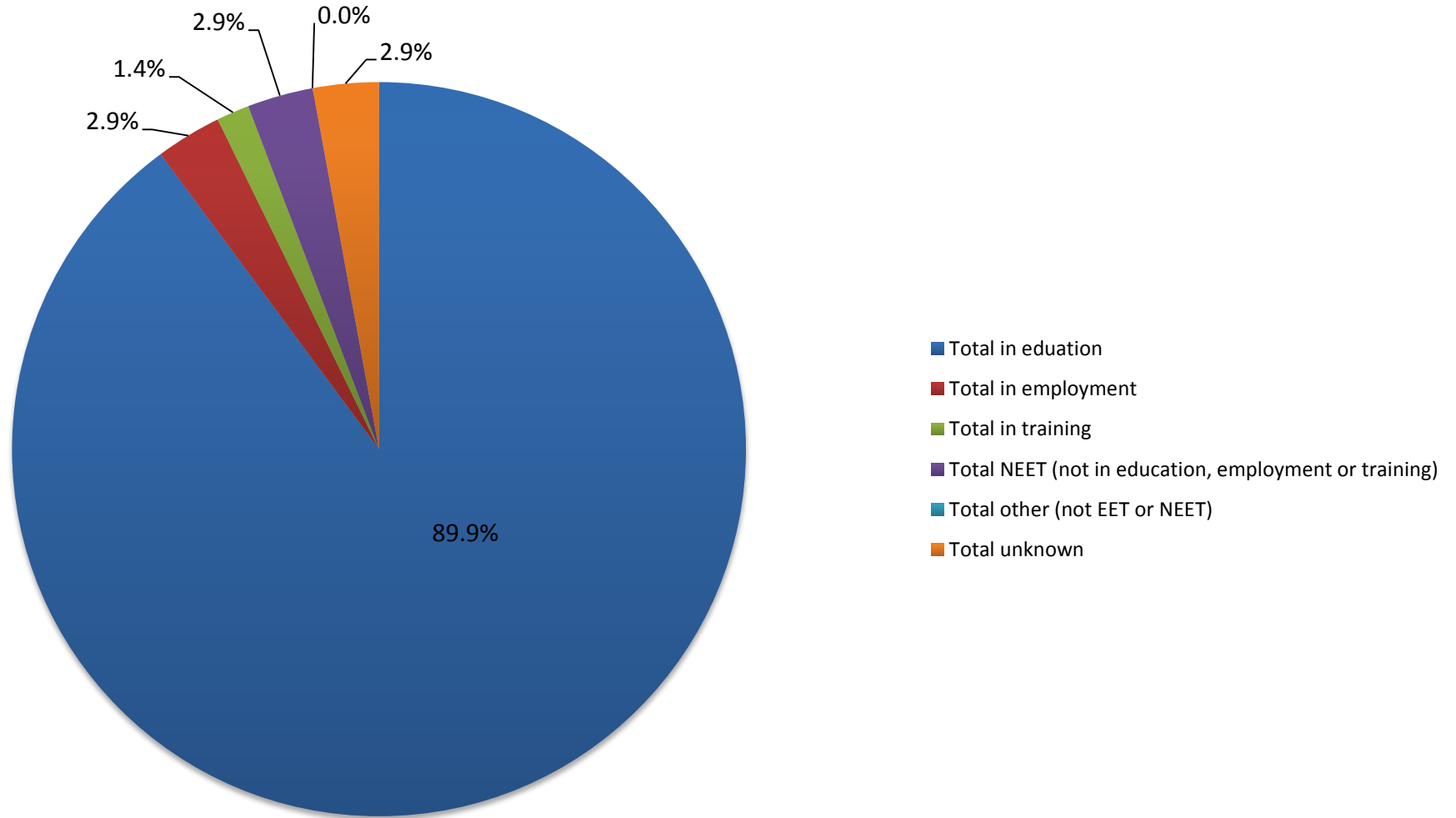


### Female leavers 2015
