



Year 7 Catch-Up Premium

Y7 Catch-up Premium – In 2017 schools received the same overall amount of year 7 Catch-Up Premium funding they received in 2015 to 2016, adjusted to reflect the percentage change in the size of their year 7 cohort, based on the October 2016 Census.

George Pindar School received £17,049.

Numeracy

- HLTA undertaking wave one and two interventions in class and out of class dependant on need and appropriateness.
- Additional in class support – Where appropriate pupils eligible for Catch-Up Premium will be provided with in class support, either through a teaching assistant or teacher.
- Pastoral Support Staff - There are many members of staff who regularly monitor and intervene with students who are struggling in school either academically or on a pastoral level. Pastoral Staff all work to support students in a variety of different ways to ensure any barriers to learning are removed allowing students to make progress. This is available to all students.
- Holiday Catch-Up Clubs – All pupils eligible for Catch-Up Premium are offered the opportunity of small group intervention with expert practitioners.

Literacy

- Additional curriculum time has been introduced to enable pupils who are eligible for Catch-Up Premium to access more literacy.
- Thinking Reading – One to one literacy intervention approach using a research based literacy methodology. Pupils undertake short and intensive literacy interventions with a trained member of staff.
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Impact on Attainment from 2016-2017 allocation.
