MathsWatch:

Username: your usual school username followed by @gps

Password: Password (with a capital P) (if that does not work, then try Mathswatch with a capital 'M')

There is a formula sheet attached to this letter. This is the absolute minimum of what you need to know and recall for your exams. You will also find a list of topics which you need to focus your revision efforts on for your PPEs at the beginning of November.
