Level 3 Catch-up Premium 2015/16

26 students were eligible for catch up premium. The split of students was:

- 19 students on Level 3 in English and Maths.
- 5 students on level 2 English.
- 5 students on level 2 Maths.
- 21 students on level 3 English.
- 21 students on level 3 Maths.

Impact

English

16 students (62%) progressed to achieve level 4 or above in English.
25 students (96%) made 1 sub level of progress or more in English.
19 students (73%) made 2 sub levels of progress or more in English.
10 students (38%) made 3 sub levels of progress or more in English.
4 students (15%) made 4 sub levels of progress or more in English.
1 student (4%) made 5 sub levels of progress or more in English.

Mathematics

17 students (65%) progressed to achieve level 4 or above in Mathematics.
25 students (96%) made 1 sub level of progress or more in Mathematics.
17 students (65%) made 2 sub levels of progress or more in Mathematics.
5 students (19%) made 3 sub levels of progress or more in Mathematics.
3 students (12%) made 4 sub levels of progress or more in Mathematics.
